

THE SECRET PLACE

Daily Meditation – Friday July 4, 2025

The Psalmist wrote, “He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the Lord, ‘My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust’” (Ps. 91:1-2)!¹ Psalm 91 is known as a Psalm of Protection. What do we need protection from? We need protection from the lies of the world and the kingdom of darkness.

Do you know when most of God’s divine revelations and blessings come to me? Early in the morning when everything is very quiet. I meditate and then rest in the secret place. Adam was producing in the Garden where it was peaceful.

Revelation also comes many times during or right after persecution. Why? The adversary puts pressure on you, and it triggers the anointing inside of you. This is why God sends the righteous among the wicked. Confidence triggers the anointing. Don’t believe the lies of the counterfeit society Satan has set up.

The Bible says, “Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour” (1 Pet. 5:8). About twenty years ago, I was invited to a Christian church for the first time. I was handed a bulletin at the door. The above verse 1 Pet. 5:8 was on the cover, and I loved it. I thought, “I have to come back next Sunday for a better one.” But the following Sunday the verse wasn’t as strong, so I went back the following week. I fell in love with the Word of God.

Isaiah is justly accounted as the chief of the writing prophets. He wrote, “For thus the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel, has said, ‘In repentance and rest you will be saved, in quietness and trust is your strength.’ But you were not willing” (Is. 30:15). Do you meditate on the Word of God and then rest? The Book of Hebrews has a whole chapter regarding rest. Sometimes I meditate on Hebrews chapter 4 every day for a week. I meditate and then rest in the secret place. The Psalmist wrote, “Be still, and know that I am God” (Ps. 46:10).
