

BOLD LIKE A LION

Daily Meditation – Saturday November 15, 2025

The Bible says, “The wicked flee when no one is pursuing, but the righteous are bold as a lion” (Pr. 28:1).¹

Prior to Jesus’ ultimate sacrifice on the cross, individuals gave sin offerings, and so forth, that only covered over the sin. However, when you receive Jesus, as your Lord and Savior, your sins are washed away never to be remembered again.

This is a vital teaching. Because Satan has no power over you once you receive Christ. Satan can only tempt, deceive and condemn you only if you let him. He has to trick your mind to believe his lie first. Do not take the bait. The Bible says, “But each one is tempted when he is dragged away, enticed and baited [to commit sin] by his own [worldly] desire (lust, passion)” (James 1:14 AMPC).

The Apostle Paul, in chapter eight, which is the high water mark, in the Book of Romans stated, “Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and as an offering for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh, so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us, who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit” (Ro. 8:1-4).

There is no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus. If the kingdom of darkness tries to condemn you take authority over those thoughts. Sin consciousness blocks your blessings. A (right standing) a righteous consciousness makes you bold as a lion.

If you are a born-again believer, God cannot condemn you because Jesus has already taken care of that for you already on the cross. Study the word, get in faith, stand straight up, pull back your shoulders, stick out your chest, and make some big bold declarations of faith. Be bold like a lion!
