

SOW AND EAT

Daily Meditation – Tuesday October 21, 2025

The Bible says, “For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return there without watering the earth and making it bear and sprout, and furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater” (Is. 55:10).¹

God has His own financial system called sowing and reaping. Though obedience sowing empowers us to sow and empowers us to eat. Eating in the above verse refers to our needs and wants being met.

There is power in the seed not in the harvest. In fact everything and anything is in the seed to get your blessings to you. There is vengeance in the seed. If God has to have an individual fired in order for Him to get the blessing to you, His child will receive whatever the Father has for him or her. Did you see in the above verse that it states “seed to the sower” first. And then “bread to the eater.” Your needs and wants move God’s heart but your seed moves God’s hand.
