WALK IN LOVE AND LIVE BY FAITH Daily Meditation – Thursday November 20, 2025

The Bible says, "Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins" (Pr. 10:12).1

Being obedient and walking in love is what we are called to. We have to try our best to let go and let God. God is our judge and will fight for us. We are not to return evil for evil. Being angry and resentful when we encounter pressure or aggravation could cost us God's protection. God hates strife. When we stop fighting God will be able to fight for us.

When we walk in love and hold our peace it gets God involved. When we are obedient it activates God's vengeance and recompense. God is just. His vengeance is rooted in His love for justice.

Do you recall the way the Israelites took Jericho? There obedience activated faith and their faith activated the angel and the angel gave them the victory.

When we walk in love and obedience God will shake the heavens and the earth if need be, and send an angel, to bless us. However, when one acts on their emotions, like fear, it is self-centered pride that God cannot bless.

As we spend much time in God's Word and then in the secret place Satan's kingdom will oppose you to get you angry. We have to response correct. Daniel's response regarding being thrown to the lions was, "O king, live forever." Daniel, a man of integrity, had no resentment and/or bitterness, regarding the situation. Your faith walk cannot rise above your love walk because faith works through love (see Gal. 5:6).

Joseph had many hard places, and we do not see him bad mouthing anyone in the scriptures. God trusted Joseph, was able to set Joseph in a place of honor, authority and power. I believe He could have the same plans for you as well.
