

## PEACE

Daily Meditation – Sunday January 18, 2026

The Bible says, “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus” (Phil. 4:6-7).<sup>1</sup>

I want to focus on four words from that verse, “The peace of God.” Adam was bearing much fruit, in the Garden of Eden, where there was peace and tranquility. “Peace is the key to our prosperity. The word peace is also defined as being in a state of harmony and tranquility and implies security and prosperity. Tranquility produces stability. Stability produces creativity. Creativity produces productivity. And productivity produces prosperity.”<sup>2</sup>

Isaiah wrote, “For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace” (Is. 9:6).

Jesus is the Prince of Peace. And Jesus gave us His peace. John, the revelator, wrote, “Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful” (Jn. 14:27).

Could you use more peace in your life? Jesus is the Prince of Peace. Allow me to give you a suggestion. Spend more time in His word. “You don’t know Jesus any better than you know His word. He dwells and lives in you by His word.”<sup>3</sup>

The Apostle Paul informed us, “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law” (Gal. 5:22-23). Keep your faith soaked in the fruit of the Spirit.
