

GOD CANNOT BLESS REBELLION

Daily Meditation – Saturday November 30, 2024

The Bible says, “But My people did not listen to My voice, and Israel did not obey Me. So I gave them over to the stubbornness of their heart, to walk in their own devices. Oh that My people would listen to Me, that Israel would walk in My ways! I would quickly subdue their enemies and turn My hand against their adversaries. Those who hate the Lord would pretend obedience to Him, and their time of punishment would be forever. But I would feed you with the finest of the wheat, and with honey from the rock I would satisfy you” (Ps. 81:11-16).¹

It seemed God had plan B set in place for rebellion. What spiritual condition do you consider the United States to be in? With all the sexual sin, drug addictions, greed, political strife, corruption, abortion and the list goes on-and-on? If you live outside the United States where do you think your nation stands? It’s vital to pray for your nation, its leaders and the unsaved individuals.

I didn’t know much about prayer until I understood the eight prayer watches. And I didn’t understand the eight prayer watches until I bought a book titled, *Enforcing Prophetic Decrees Volume 2: Prayer Watch for Community Transformation* by Archbishop Nicholas Duncan-Williams. He is considered an apostle of strategic prayer. Most days my wife and I pray that book throughout the day. It is very powerful. A powerful prayer life is vital in these last days.

God’s nature is to bless, however, He can’t bless rebellion. In verse sixteen he says, “I would feed you with the finest of the wheat, and with honey from the rock I would satisfy you.” Wow, God says, “Honey from a rock.” Moses mentioned this term in his song. He wrote, “He made him ride on the high places of the earth, and he ate the produce of the field; and He made him suck honey from the rock, and oil from the flinty rock, curds of cows, and milk of the flock, with fat of lambs, and rams, the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the finest of the wheat – and of the blood of grapes you drank wine” (Deut. 36:13-14).

Do you know one of the most important things you can have in this life? A strong prayer life would be my answer. I stated previously that I didn’t understand the eight prayer watches. I am so glad I know about them now!
