## **GOD'S ATTRIBUTES**

Daily Meditation - Tuesday November 18, 2025

Let us meditate on some of God's attributes so we can catch a revelation of there importance. They will help increase our capacity and strengthen our inner man.

Omnipotence is defined as having unlimited power. Omnipotence regarding the Father: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Gen 1:1).

Omniscience is a state of knowing everything. Omniscience regarding the Father: "O Lord, You have searched me and known me. You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. You scrutinize my path and my lying down, and are intimately acquainted with all my ways. Even before there is a word on my tongue, behold, O Lord, You know it all. You have enclosed me behind and before, and laid Your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is too high, I cannot attain to it" (Ps. 139:1-6).<sup>1</sup>

Omnipresence is being everywhere at the same time. Omnipresence regarding the Father: "Am I a God who is near,' declares the Lord, 'And not a God far off? Can a man hide himself in hiding places so I do not see him?' declares the Lord. 'Do I not fill the heavens and the earth?' declares the Lord" (Jer. 23:23-24).

Love regarding the Father: "The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love" (1 John 4:8).

Holiness regarding the Father: "Your way, O God, is holy; what god is great like our God" (Ps. 77:13)?

Righteousness regarding the Father: What is the difference between holiness and righteousness? "Righteousness is holiness in action," is one answer. Righteousness is God's holiness manifested in right dealing with his creatures. "Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right" (Gen. 18:25)?<sup>2</sup>

Faithful regarding the Father: "He is absolutely trustworthy. His words will not fail; therefore, His people may stand on His promises" (Lk. 18:7; 1 Cor. 1:9).

PRAYER FOR SALVATION – Father God, I repent of all my sins, and I believe You raised Jesus from the dead. I confess that Jesus Christ is the Lord of my life. Jesus, wash me with your holy blood. Holy Spirit fill me so I can be a mighty witness for King Jesus!
