

AMBASSADORS ALWAYS ACTIVATE THEIR AUTHORITY AND ABUNDANT ANGELS

Daily Meditation – Friday August 14, 2026

When Adam sinned, in the Garden of Eden, he gave authority to Satan who is now the god of this world (see 2 Cor. 4:4). However, Jesus Christ was obedient all the way to death on the cross and has defeated Satan. When you receive Jesus Christ, as your Lord and Savior, you receive the authority that Adam had.

Let us examine why God gave Adam authority. The Bible says, “Then God said, ‘Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.’ God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. God blessed them; and God said to them, ‘Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth’” (Gen. 1:26-28).¹

God gave Adam authority to rule the earth. The same reason He gives every born-again Christian authority, to rule and reign here in the earth. When an individual gets born-again, God infuses the kingdom of God into that individual’s spirit. As they mature in Christ, they learn to tap into the kingdom of God (production center) inside of them. They also learn to release their authority with spoken words of faith, from their mouth. Angels assist believers. Angels are waiting on our words (see Heb. 1:13-14).

Demons are also waiting on our words. That is why it is so important to reframe from complaining and all negative speech. The Bible says, “Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit” (Pr. 18:21). When you examine Jesus’ ministry, while He was on earth, you will find about ninety-five percent of His ministry was accomplished with words of faith!

The Bible says in Hebrews 3:1 that Jesus is the Apostle and High Priest of our confession. We are to use our authority and confess faith, just like Jesus.
