

NEVER BE MOVED / NOT BE MOVED

Daily Meditation – Friday January 2, 2026

The Bible says, “For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning. And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved” (Ps. 30:5-6).¹

As I studied my Bible our topic arrested my attention. After much study, I discovered our topic is mentioned in many different Psalms, however; I believe it is only mentioned by David the mighty warrior. Remember what David stated? He said, “Blessed be the Lord, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle” (Ps. 144:1). In these last days, we will need to be strong and grounded in faith. And faith comes by hearing the word (see Rom. 10:17).

Let us examine three sets of verses David wrote. (1) “Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved” (Ps. 55:22). (2) “He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved” (Ps. 62:6). And lastly, “O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of his praise to be heard: which holdeth our soul in life, and suffereth not our feet to be moved” (Ps. 66:8-9).

Doctor Luke mentioned David in the New Testament. He wrote, “For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved” (Acts 2:25).

The Apostle Paul made a very powerful statement in his letter to the Colossians. He said, “If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister” (Col. 1:23).

You, like David, are a mighty warrior. Therefore, can I give you a suggestion? Meditate these aforementioned verses and get them deep down in your Spirit.
