

ETERNAL LIFE / OR THE WRATH OF GOD

Daily Meditation – Monday November 17, 2025

The Bible says, “He who comes from above is above all, he who is of the earth is from the earth and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all. What He has seen and heard, of that He testifies; and no one receives His testimony. He who has received His testimony has set his seal to this, that God is true. For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure. The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hand. He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him” (Jn. 3:31-36).¹

Those are very powerful words spoken in those verses. It certainly does not look good for the individual that does not obey the Son. When I think of an individual of having either eternal life or the wrath of God abiding on him, I think of a revelation I received earlier. Let me explain.

I was thinking about the many years I have been a street evangelist, and many thousands who have prayed with me. I was thinking of the ones who were so willing to pray and also how happy and content they were after praying. Then I got a revelation of the millions that may be ready right now, today, to come into the kingdom.
