

## VICTORY

Daily Meditation – Thursday August 28, 2025

The Bible says, “I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace and confidence. In the world you have tribulation and trials and distress and frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world. [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you]” (Jn. 16:33 AMPC).

Did you hear that? He deprived it of power to harm you. Let me say that again. He deprived it of power to harm you. Do you remember that old song? There’s victory in Jesus my Lord and my Savior. He washed me, and cleansed me with His redeeming blood”!

Do not pay any attention to these light afflictions. The Apostle Paul said, “For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory” (1 Cor. 4:17 KJV). Just remember you always have the victory.
