ROSE CUP FACTS AND RULES SHEET SUMMER 2022

Features 6 Levels of Play

- BB Level = Advanced+ Level of Play
- CC Level = Intermediate+ Level of Play
- Over 50 = Open All Levels Must be 50 years old
- Over 35 = Open All Levels Must be 35 years old
- C Level = Intermediate Level of Play
- Rec. = Beginner Level of Play
- Maximum Roster 17 Skaters (17 players to include goalies)
- Guaranteed 3 Games (4th game will be Championship Game 1st vs. 2nd in round robin)
- 3 20 minute running time periods
- Trophy to winning team in each division
- All games played at Mountain View Ice Arena
- Scorekeepers & Referees provided

All players must be 18 years of age on or before June 13th, 2014 (Players must be able to show ID at check in and at any point during the tournament)

Per Team Charge:

- \$1600.00 Team Fee. Team Fees must be paid in full before any of its players take the ice. \$600.00 non-refundable deposit holds your teams spot in the tournament.
- No individual payments will be accepted
- 4 6 teams per level will be accepted. Some levels may have more teams and as time permits. Schedule requests will be accepted only when deposit is made and will be on a first come first serve basis.
- Rosters will be locked at the start of the first game. Only players on a team's roster are eligible to play for that team. Any player taking the ice that is not on the roster will be dismissed and that team must pay a \$100.00 fine. All players must be able to show ID at any time during the tournament.
- No additions to the rosters can be made after the start of the first game.

Sand Bag Rule:

- If a team declared by the Tournament Director to have "Sand Bagged" in a division below the actual skill level of your team, will be declared ineligible to play in the medal round.
- Tournament Director reserves the right to declare any player ineligible if player is deemed a "Sand Bagger"

Rules and Regulations: TEAM REPS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PLAYERS KNOWLEDGE OF RULES (Please read them to your teams before the first game)

- All levels are NON-Check
- Zero Tolerance! Abuse of other players, referees, scorekeepers or rink property will be grounds for dismissal from tournament!
- Fighting will get you suspended from Tournament
- 3 Minor penalties or 9 penalty minutes will result in a retirement of player from game.
- All Major penalties and/or 10 minute Misconduct penalties will result in suspension from the next game.
- 2nd Major penalty and/or 10 minute misconduct penalty will result in suspension from tournament.
- Stop time last 2 minutes of a game that is within 2 goals
- Games within 3 goals will have a 30 seconds stop time at end of period.
- 1-1 minute time out (at any time during the game)
- Tie games will be decided by a (3 shooter) shootout. Visiting team will shoot first. Followed by sudden death shootout, with different shooters, until a winner been determined.
- Tied Championship Games will have a 5 minute 3 vs. 3 sudden death over time period. If still tied a 5 player shootout to decide with different shooters, until a winner been determined.
- Regulation win = 3 pts, Tie game shootout winner = 2 pts, Tie game shootout loser = 1 pt.
- Tie Breaker: Wins, Points, Head to Head, Fewest Penalty Minutes, Coin Toss.
- The +/- for any team can be no more than 5 goals per game
- Tag-up offs will be allowed, In the case of a delayed offside, the attacking team will have the opportunity to tag-up, allowing play to flow and keep the number of stoppages to a minimum.
- The MVIA Adult Rose Cup Tournament has adopted the rule of blue line icing.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises. Any player visibly intoxicated will be removed from the premises.
