

Ballet Etudes will do our utmost to adhere to the CDC social distancing guidelines. The following procedures have been put in place to ensure the health and safety of our Dancers:

General:

- Any dancer showing signs or symptoms of illness must remain at home.
- The lobby will be closed – Parents and visitors will not be allowed to congregate inside the building at any time.
- All payments and office issues can be handled through portal, email or over the phone. If parents need to come into studio for any issues proper social distancing at desk must be maintained.
- Lunches may be brought and placed in fridge but must be properly labeled and containers removed daily to allow for cleaning. Any containers left will be thrown away each day. Deliveries will be allowed but desk volunteers must be notified, in order to meet drivers at the door.

Arrival

- Upon arrival each dancer's temperature will be taken at the door by the volunteers. – If student has a fever, they will be sent home.
- Students will be directed to the studio where their first class will take place.
- Students will not be permitted to bring in large dance bags. All bags must be able to comfortably stay at dancers' feet during class. (similar in size to backpack)

Classroom

- The barres and all high touch areas will be wiped down and cleaned throughout the day.
- Markings have been placed on barres and floors to keep dancers spaced no less than 6ft apart for all barre and center work

Departure

- At the end of the day the dancers will stay in place in last studio where they attended class. A desk volunteer will stand in entry way and greet parents as they pull up or arrive to door. A desk volunteer will then go and collect student from classroom, to avoid congregation in lobby.
- All studios will be wiped down with disinfectant and cleaned at the end of each day.
