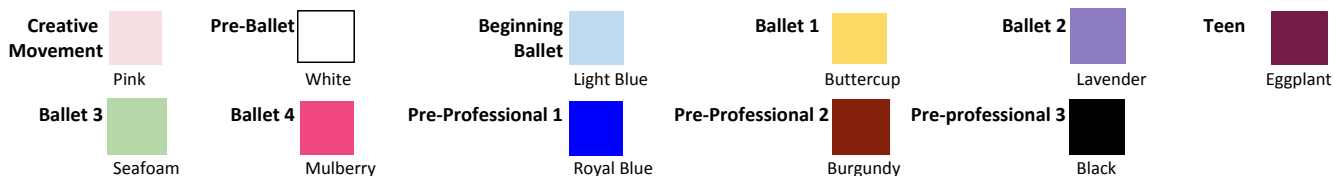

**Tuition** Tuition is due on the 1st of each month payable via cash, check, or credit card. A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged after the 15th. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any returned check. NO REFUNDS OR DEDUCTIONS for missed classes; you may schedule a make-up class at the front desk within 30 days of missed class. **Dress Code - Ballet** **Male** - Black tights, dance pants, or shorts; white t-shirt; and black ballet shoes.  
**Female** - Level-designated basic leotard (see below for color); pink tights; and pink ballet shoes. Hair must be secured in a bun. No skirts or warm ups may be worn in ballet class.



**- Non-Ballet** Dance clothing that enables free movement. Hair should be pulled back and out of the face. Each class may have a specific shoe requirement; the class instructor will provide shoe requirements.

- \* No gum or food permitted in the dance room. Water is permitted.
  - \* All classes are subject to change and are subject to a minimum size requirement.
  - \* No parents or visitors are allowed in the classroom during instruction without invitation.
  - \* Dancers are expected to treat the staff and facility with respect. Please help keep our studio clean.

**Level Placement** All level placements are at the discretion of the teaching staff at BE School of Dance and subject to the approval of the School Director. New students should schedule a placement class with a member of our front desk staff; placement classes are offered from our existing schedule and will be with other students of similar dance training. The placement class fee is \$10 for tech and \$15 for tech & pointe; and is valid for first class only (additional classes may be tried at drop-in rates). Current students will receive level placement for following Fall session prior to the beginning of the next Fall semester.

**Registration** Class registration is handled at our front desk on the first day of classes attended. The annual registration fee is \$25.00 per student; the annual fee covers the period of August through July.

**Safety** If any Ballet Etudes volunteers or staff must stay with your child after class or rehearsal ends, there will be a \$10.00 service fee after the first 10 minutes and a \$5.00 fee for every 5 minutes after that. The fee will be assessed and billed to the parent's account. Please call the studio to notify the office if you will be late due to an emergency.

**The first day of classes for Fall 2019 will be Monday, August 12, 2019. Classes will resume January 6, 2020 after Winter Break.**  
**The last day of regular classes will be Saturday, May 23, 2020.**
