Seeking For Jesus

On Sunday we continued in our study of the **Book of John**. We are now in **chapter six** and focused on **verses 22-29**. The Word of God never ceases to inspire and intrigue us. *Verse 22 begins, "The day following..."* And you may not automatically recall what happened the day before, but it was the Miracle of Feeding the 5,000. (This only counted the men, so there were more likely closer to 20,000 or more with women and children.) So, on this day beginning in verse 22 the people get up and go back to where Jesus was the night before, but they could not find Him! They had seen the disciples get into a ship and cross to the other side, but they had no idea what had happened to Jesus.

Verse 24 says, "When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither His disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus."

Can you picture it? The crowd sought after Jesus. They were more than ready for another "show"! (Have you heard about Jesus? Did you see His miracles? Maybe there really is a God who cares about us. And the potluck lunch was amazing!) Word of Jesus and His miracles spread quickly throughout Judea and Galilee. The crowd wanted what they could get from Jesus and were really clueless--not knowing Jesus was not a teacher come from God, but was in fact, God come to teach. We would say "it was a BIG DEAL"; it was "THE THING" at least at this point in His ministry!

People in the crowd wanted to be a part of what everyone else in the crowd was doing. While the people followed the crowd, Jesus was following His Father! So, this brings a few simple questions to mind--1) *If or when* you decide to join with others to worship God, do you go to *WATCH* worship or to *GIVE* worship to the Father? (*John 4:24*), 2) Are there really people today who are genuinely **seeking for Jesus**? We believe there are some who are seeking Him for the right reasons and we want to be counted among those.
