

Time for Tribulation?

*These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace.
In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer;
I have overcome the world.
John 16:33*

John 16:33 has long been a favorite verse in our lives. It serves as a calming, reassuring marker when life is filled with turmoil, struggle, trial, and tribulation. At times it seems everywhere you turn (whether in the world, in the country, in a local community, or in our home or hearts) there is exhausting struggle on a grand scale. Perhaps we are now of an age that we observe more around us instead of focusing mostly on ourselves. Jesus' words are so very clear... **"in the world ye shall have tribulation..."**. Sounds like a given. So, why are we surprised when it comes? We might think: *We want to avoid this. We don't deserve this.* In many ways that might even be true, yet Jesus says it's going to happen. Period.

This specific verse reminds us that we can only find Peace in Jesus alone--**"that in Me ye might have peace"**--**"be of good cheer; I have overcome the world."** What an astounding statement He makes here! We can have Peace. We can be Optimistic. How? When we focus on Jesus--His Peace, His Strength, His Power and His Ability to overcome... anything! It doesn't mean the tribulation or trial or turmoil will be removed from our lives, but that we may still find Peace and Good Cheer in the midst of it. How amazing is that?

Then, Paul expands this perspective in **Romans 5:3**, **"...but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience..."** Most of us aren't **quite** ready to **"glory"** in our troubles and trials. But if we would grow in doing this, patience would also grow and develop in us. Yes, it is a struggle. But, Yes, it is possible--in Christ Jesus, alone!
