Race #5 of our 2025 points series, since this is a points race driver can enter only once per class but can enter another class if car meets class requirements.
Buy backs for first round runner up \$20.00 paid in lanes (buy backs races each other winners go to round 2 of main race) No points for Buy Back round.
All random pairings, till after round 2 then ladder based on best reaction time for remaining rounds. No lane swapping once in staging lanes. During random pairing rounds, a random potential bye will be picked via card draw.
