




super dalmatians

Super Dalmatians are identified by their coverage, not just how many spots they possess. For example; the freckled and the ink on this chart are both considered super, eventhough the ink has less spots than the freckled but more coverage.

Tip: you shouldn't have to count spots to find out if you have a super.

You'll also find that dalmatians overlap many morphs, that's because it's a trait - not a morph!

multi-coloured

These are often referred to as Confetti, which name originates from Altitude Exotics' Confetti line. Whilst there are a few lines of this type of dalmatian, such as Monstrums Chili line or the very first Party Dal, we are yet to have a name for this trait in general.

Multi-coloured dalmatians can come in red, orange, white, green and black.
