- IV. Treasurer Report – Approved by Doug, 2nd by Leah.
- V. Welcome guests: Justin Shaver, Dave Washburn, Octavia and Robert Hirons.
- VI. Dave Washburn – Dave inquired about signs for the Community Market, Village sign rules will be followed and signs will only be up during the market. Dave also inquired to Sharon about what capacity she was attending in, Sharon replied that she's a member and the Treasurer of the SCA, not representing the Village. Dave also requested an apology for comments made online about "working with the Village for a year on market replacement."
