

# CREATING A COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL COUNSELING PROGRAM

SUGGESTED IMPLEMENTATION CALENDAR (YEAR ONE)

### **DESCRIPTION**

This document is to help schools and districts implement a comprehensive school counseling program aligned with the ASCA National Model. This is meant to be a step-by-step process, as outlined below. Note: "Year One" does not mean it is only for first year school counselors. Instead, it is designed for year one of fully implementing a comprehensive school counseling program. If you have some components in place already, please adapt the calendar as needed for your situation.

     Ideally, after the school counselors have this meeting, they have time to process and share their successes and areas for growth for next year's meeting.
