Reminders and Covid-19 Questions (If you answer yes to questions 1, 2 or 3, contact our camp director before coming to camp)

1. Have you or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the last 21 days: sore throat, cough, chills, body aches for unknown reasons, shortness of breath for unknown reasons, loss of smell, loss of taste, fever at or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit?
2. Do you have any reason to believe you or anyone in your household has been exposed to or acquired COVID-19?
3. To the best of your knowledge have you been in close proximity to any individual who tested positive for COVID-19?
4. If another family member or your camper has recently tested positive, there is a minimum 5-day quarantine and you must speak with a director about when your child can return to camp.

Important Camp Reminders:

Parents should always enter Camp Summertime from Mulholland Hwy and Calamigos Rd. Follow the Camp Summertime signs to drop-off and pick-up. All parents will use our drive through pick up and drop off area each day where a Director will check in your camper at your car. All campers will be brought back to drive through pick up zone in the afternoon with parents waiting in their cars. If you arrive at camp after 9:30 a.m. and before 3:15 p.m., call the camp office when you arrive at the check-in/check-out tent so a staff can meet you at the tent. Parents cannot enter the camp property during camp hours for added safety.

- ✓ **CAMPERS MUST BRING WATER BOTTLES EACH DAY!**
- ✓ All online forms including Camper Information and Medical, must be filled out for each camper before 1st day of camp.
- ✓ All Campers must come to camp wearing their swimsuits under their clothes. They can change out of their swimsuits after swim or water games in our individual private pop-up changing tents.
- ✓ Campers may wear facemasks at camp if they would like but they are not required to do so.
- ✓ Campers must wear closed toed shoes.
- ✓ The weekly notice will tell you about any special weekly themes.
- ✓ Please label all clothing, towels, lunch boxes and backpacks.
- ✓ Please put sunscreen on your child before each camp day and send a bottle as well with them to reapply at camp!!
- ✓ Any missed days, for any reason, including missed days due to any illness including Covid-19 exposure or positive test, may have makeup days this summer if room is available. Refunds or future credit for future summers is not available.
