All carcase hoggs must be at Thainstone Centre on Tuesday 25th February for weighing between 2-3pm.

All carcase hoggs must be shown in a natural state, any hoggs dressed, brushed or trimmed in any way will be disqualified.

Hoggs will be judged on the Hoof at the Show and on the Hook at Morrison's Woodhead, Turriff the following day.

Entrants are invited to view the hogg carcases on Thursday 27th February at 6pm prompt at the Turriff premises of Morrisons Woodhead, Turriff.

The presentation of the carcase prizes will follow after Stovies are served to which all entrants of carcases are welcome.

PLEASE NOTE Consignors must have a Morrison's Account set up by 1st February and be a member of the Farm Assurance Scheme.
