


Dear Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York Family,

Words cannot express all that my heart is feeling as I sit to write your congratulatory

I shall never forget, the earliest days of Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, Los Angeles, meeting in the Ebony Showcase Theater. There was a young man sitting, weekly, in the rear of the building, always on time, and giving his undivided attention to every detail of the service. I saw him laugh and, often, cry as he sought God's direction for his life.

I too, at the time, was totally dependent upon the Holy Spirit's guidance as the path was being revealed to us all, and then it happened! I clearly heard the Spirit speak to me saying, "this young man will do great things in this work." I did not know his name nor anything about him. As I stood in the back door, at the end of service, sending the parishioners out with their weekly hugs and kisses, I took his hand in mine, looked into his eyes, and shared what God had spoken to me. He looked very puzzled, smiled, and replied, "who me?" I said, "yes you," and thus, God's prophetic word has manifested.

That young man is your Pastor and Sr. Bishop of the Unity Fellowship Church Movement, Sr. Bishop Zachary G. Jones.

He served, faithfully, as my first assistant pastor in the Mother Church. He was sent out to establish our first sister church, Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York City. You heard his call, answered, and for the last 25 years you've worked tirelessly feeding, clothing, housing, visiting, educating, baptizing, christening, marrying, burying, healing, and liberating all those God sent your way.

Yes, you've weathered every storm, dismantled opposition, fought for social justice, endured all forms of oppression....within and without! Your continued existence proves, again and again.... "GOD IS LOVE!"




25 years of service

Bishop Jones, how did you feel when you actually arrived in New York City, regarding the assignment that was the result of your "Yes to the Lord" and the subsequent responsibility?

I was both overwhelmed and fearful. New York was a big place and I was 32 years old, a very young man. But I was confident and I felt like I had the tools. I had received excellent training and had a great support system through Archbishop Carl Bean. But it still was an intimidating assignment, and I am glad that I did it and I am glad that I persevered the best that I could.

Bishop Jones, in all your years of ministry how has your faith strengthened as you elevated through the ranks of Minister, Reverend, Pastor, Elder, to now being a Senior Bishop?

I went from Minister in 1978 to Assistant Pastor for Archbishop in 1987. Between 1978 and 1983 I was educating myself by going to seminary and going to college. I certainly had my faith strengthened because I was a very young man, only 18, when I went into ministry. I have been a minister longer than I was an adult. I have always had to look at my life, my career choices, my vocational calling, Reverend, Pastor, Elder, Bishop, to Senior Bishop. One of the more prevalent ways that my faith was used was when I came to the Unity Fellowship Movement, because I was initially licensed through the Baptist Church. Then I graduated from Life Bible College, which was sponsored by the Foursquare Church community as well as the faith communities of the Dr. Ed Dufresne Ministries. So I had to use my faith when I came into Unity Fellowship because many of those roles were not defined. I was the first Assistant Pastor of the Mother Church; one of the first Elders of the Movement; one of the first Bishops of the Movement, one of the first churches that grew outside of the Mother Church; first Senior Pastor of Unity Fellowship movement denomination, so I have defined all these roles, and it took a lot of faith to define these various roles. It takes faith to grow to hear God's call, hear His direction, hear His voice. My faith has always been there because it is the lenses by which I see the world in which I live. So it has always been there through elevation, helping me and providing me with the confidence, providing me with the sense of capability and abilities to carry out those roles. I don't think if I didn't have my faith I would not have been able to do those jobs.



The most challenging aspect of my ministry was the lack of colleagues in doing what we have uniquely done. Christianity and the ministry is a very unique role in and of itself, but many people operate from within their denominational circles and because Unity Fellowship was such a progressive "out" work, particularly among the black Christian community, there were a lot of African American people who are in the clergy who just don't associate with us. I have tried to be a part of the church counsels, different groups, gatherings, card exchanges, etc. Our world is so complex and so demanding and it takes so much to just live, that finding social time to be friends and with friends, especially of the same vocation, has been the greatest challenge. I just wish that life was simpler for everybody.

Bishop Jones, how do you feel now in comparison to 25 years ago?

Accomplished! I feel accomplished! There are no more "must do's", "must haves". I was sitting in the empty seat tonight thinking what it felt like to have my own building as a pastor. We've done that! We have built churches. We blessed others to come and train. We have provided a training ground for other pastors. We were part of the African American LGBT Movement. We were front and center. We had articles written about our work from the New York Post to the New York Times. We featured on television programs, in various textbooks within religious institutions. We received awards and accolades from the NAACP, from every gay organization, both African American as well as other mixed groups. We have recently received an award from the largest gay newspaper periodical, The Gay City News. So how do I feel now versus from 25 years ago? ACCOMPLISHED!

Bishop Jones, in 25 years of ministry, have you ever wanted to just walk way?

NEVER! Of course there are discouraging moments that we all experience in work. But, my ministry and my church have always been a part of me. People ask me often why I don't just go into the full time Bishopric. Because I love pastoring! I just never considered that as an option.







It is with great pride and excitement that I pen this congratulatory message to you. What an amazing blessing to celebrate 25 years of serving the people of God. Your authentic charismatic leadership, has inspired countless people in NYC to reconnect with our creator God. In the early nineties, the message of a God, who offers unconditional love to same gender loving people, was and continues to be a life - saving message.







Our mission is carried out through the valuing of ourselves, as God has made us and the valuing of our heritage, including but not exclusively, the historical and literal teachings of Jesus Christ, as man and deity. The valuing of our community is demonstrated as we feed the hungry, clothe the naked, support and offer love to those who are incarcerated and those who suffer hardships.

Enlightenment and revelation are continuous and did not stop with the Bible writers.



Bishop Jones' Reflections

From 20 Year Anniversary



Twenty years have gone by; I wonder where the time went. Many faces and places that made up our church family and history are gone. I am overwhelmed with excitement of what's ahead, as well, humbled by the experience of God choosing folks like us to do His work.

In preparing for this event I was thumbing through some photographs of our earlier years. I was reminded of the precious souls who have come and shared this journey with us; people like, Deborah, who we called Dee. I remember how she loved to sing in the choir. She had been away from church for so many years because of the church's stand on homosexuals at the time, yet she never left God. God brought her to Unity Fellowship and she sung just like an angel. She sung with excitement and glee until cancer took her life.

I remember Deacon Lucky who wanted to be a Deacon so bad that she tried to go to Los Angeles to get ordained and her health would not allow her to go. Deacon Lucky was a woman in pants and a man's suit and was also told by the church in her young adult life, that she could not be a deacon. The Archbishop in his infinite wisdom came to New York to ordain her as a Deacon, and she departed this world as "Deacon Dorothy Lucky Bryant." I remember Ralph who could never stop talking about the sermons and his weekly experience at Unity. Even on his last day here on Earth, he was getting ready to come to church, but never made it.

I remember the first Deacon's Board and the talented people God gave us to set this work in motion; I like to think of them as founding Parents. The angels of our time which include but are not limited to: Deacon Charles Brack, April Lee, Dionne Freeney, Pastor Jeff Haskins, Pastor Gale Jones, Elder Antonio Jones, Bishop Holland, Rev. Janyce Jackson, Richard Harris, Dr. Marjorie Hill, Shep Brown, Regina Shavers, Bishop Stephenson, Pastor Valerie Holly, Noel Francis and so many more. I remember the crowds both at The Center, and at St. Mary's, and all the wonderful people of St. Mary's like Father Hamilton, Tony Gomes, and our favorite warden, Ms. Edwards. These people are all special people who are still very much in the fabric of our work. I honor them today and all that they have given to us.

I am grateful for the life of service that God has called me to do. I am grateful for the miraculous testimonies of healings, purposeful living, and reconnection to God our Creator and Savior. I am grateful for the love and friendships (BFFL) that were formed because of Unity Fellowship Church. I am grateful to Jesus who suffered that we could all be free. I am grateful for my mother and father who insisted that I go to church even when they could not attend due to their work schedules. I am grateful for "grandma's hand," who offered early years of supervision in my parent's absence. I am grateful to my Archbishop who has had faith and trust in me to represent the most valuable part of his life, the church of Jesus Christ. I am grateful for the beautiful people with their different personalities, likes and dislikes. We are all God's children!

The Unity Fellowship Church Movement was founded in 1982 in Los Angeles, California, and was incorporated and chartered as a non-profit organization in Los Angeles, California in the year 1985. The "Mother Church," also known as Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, was located in Los Angeles, CA at 5148 West Jefferson Blvd.

The inspiration of vision to establish Unity Fellowship of Christ Church was given to its Founder, Archbish-op Carl Bean. After many years of study and seeking spiritual truth, it was revealed to him that the spiritual path is eternal and travelled by all. Archbishop Carl Bean in his dream, vision, and other heightened spiritual experiences, was given the lesson that nothing compares with, is equal to, or surpasses love, for "GOD IS LOVE AND LOVE IS FOR EVERYONE."

In 1992 the call for an extended work in New York City was made to Archbishop Bean from the Lavender Light LGBT Gospel Choir, which included Charles Brock. The Bishop Zachary G. Jones answered the call. Bishop Jones moved to New York, and opened the New York City chapter of the Unity Fellowship Church Movement. Bishop Jones' first service was held on May 10, 1992 at the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual & Transgender Community Center, on West 13th Street, in Manhattan.

In 1994 Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York City moved to share worship space at Saint Mary's Episcopal Church at 230 Classon Avenue in Brooklyn, New York. This remained a home for Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York City until 2003. Saint Mary's was a Godsend, because we had quickly run out of room at the LGBT Center.


In 2003 Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York City was blessed to relocate to its home at 2578 Atlantic Avenue, in the East New York neighborhood of Brooklyn. It was UFC-NYC's hope to one day own that property; but unfortunately, gentrification of that neighborhood exponentially increased property values almost overnight. Increasing real estate prices forced UFC-NYC to examine future options for where we would be located. UFC-NYC continued to grow in numbers and focused on its mission, and "the power of love and God has kept this work alive for fifteen years," stated Bishop Zachary G Jones.

In 2012 Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York City relocated to the historic National Black Theatre at 2031 Fifth Avenue, in Harlem. Up until 2012, Bishop Zachary G. Jones had given birth to four of the UFC Movement churches; to Breaking Ground, a youth and young adult community project; and to at least 5 other churches in New York City, not a part of the UFC Movement. UFC-NYC has opened doors for many of New York's LGBT people of faith.

In 2015 Unity Fellowship of Christ Church, New York City collaborated with St. Mary's Episcopal Church, in the Manhattanville neighborhood of West Harlem, and relocated to the church, which is at 521 West 126th Street. Bishop Zachary G. Jones is elated to be able to team with such a supportive house of worship, where their mission statement and social justice ministries almost match those of UFC-NYC. UFC-NYC and St. Mary's are working so well together, and great efforts are being made to support each other in many of the common ministries. We look forward to a long and lasting relationship with St. Mary's Episcopal Church.









