Among the various activities of Mt. Ebal, the camp meeting holds highest importance in the minds of the people. At one time there was a large arbor here and the grounds were covered with tents at camp meeting time. The arbor is gone and the tents have long since been removed but the church is still well preserved. The pastor of Denton Central Methodist church has supervision of the church but there are no longer regular services at the church and the membership has gone to other churches.
