History, Religious Values Preserved At Church

Services come but once a year at Mt. Ebal Memorial Church (above), which is off Sexton Road east of Denton. The Mt. Ebal Assn., a group that maintains and oversees the 19th century structure, will hold the annual service at 11:45 this Sunday morning. The Rev. Tom Griffith of Yadkinville Methodist Church, great-grandson of a member of Mt. Ebal Memorial Church, will perform the service, which will be followed by a picnic on the church grounds. Mt. Ebal was the original Methodist church for its area of Davidson County, according to church association member Mrs. D.M. Sexton. Regular services at the church were discontinued in the late 1930s, she said. In the picture on the right, association member Pete Sexton plays the church's organ, which was manufactured by the old Shipman Organ Co. in High Point.
