Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Murphy, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

Board Members Present:

- Supervisor Murphy, Clerk Scott, Treasurer Kovalski, Trustee Couture, Trustee Greenleaf

Motion to Approve Minutes:

- Motion by Kovalski, seconded by Couture, to approve the minutes from the July 13, 2026 meeting.

Guest Introduction and Citizens Present:

- Brad Heineman, Jason Owen, Anthony Kendrek, Jim and Linda Strickland, Jackie and Joseph McKelvie, Austin Pratt, Brandon Bise, Morgan Sely, Debbie Rutherford, Dennis Scott.

Citizens' Concerns: Mr. Owen, Mr. McKelvie and Mr. Kendrek expressed concerns about the need to draft an ordinance regarding Flock Safety cameras.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Kovalski commented that she has no concerns.

Clerk's Report:

- **Clerk Scott** reported that early voting went well and explained why the township bills were higher than usual. The state sent the Township a check for \$25,681.80 that should have gone to Clinton Township Macomb, election expense was \$7,821.05 and the Cemetery had to pay for storm cleanup.

Motion by Scott, seconded by Greenleaf, to pay \$10,515.22 for the 209 Riverside Cemetery bills.
Vote: 5 Yes, 0 No. Motion passed.

Motion Scott, seconded by Kovalski to approve, to pay \$10,233.39 for the 206 Fire bills.

Vote: 5 Yes, 0 No. Motion passed.

Supervisor's Report:

- **Riverside Cemetery:** Supervisor Murphy reported that several trees have fallen in the cemetery and that we are looking into having the insurance company re-imburse us the cost of cleanup.

New Business: none

Old Business:

1. **Building Inspector Training:** The Building Inspector needs to attending a training program in September or October at a cost of \$1,500. Tecumseh Township will split the cost and Clinton Township will pay \$750.

Motion by Scott, seconded by Greenleaf, to pay \$750.00 for the Building Inspector to attend required training.
