About us: BYR Youth

Black York Region Youth (BYR Youth) was founded in 2020 by adult mentor and leader Vanessa Stoby, a York Region teacher, and four youth: Sydney Baxter, Cameron Davis, Rachel Cheng, and Hannah Mullings-Tatum. The organization was founded to combat anti-Black racism, systemic racism, anti-Indigenous hate, and discrimination in all of its forms within the Greater Toronto Area.

Over the years, BYR Youth has continued to grow into a group of almost 30 passionate BIPOC Youth and allies who are driving the change the founders envisioned for their communities.

BYR Youth continues its mission by curating thoughtful events for Black Youth, supporting community initiatives, and advocating on Black Youth's behalf— whether at the municipal, provincial, or federal level.

BYR Youth 1st Black Youth Gala:
BYR Youth’s 1st Black Youth Gala in February 2024 was a red carpet event celebrating the past, present and future. The event was an opportunity for the achievements of Black youth to be celebrated with community members. The event consisted of 144 youth and adult attendees, where 8 Black youth were awarded scholarships for post-secondary. Additionally, several Black youth visual artists and performers had the chance to showcase their talents.

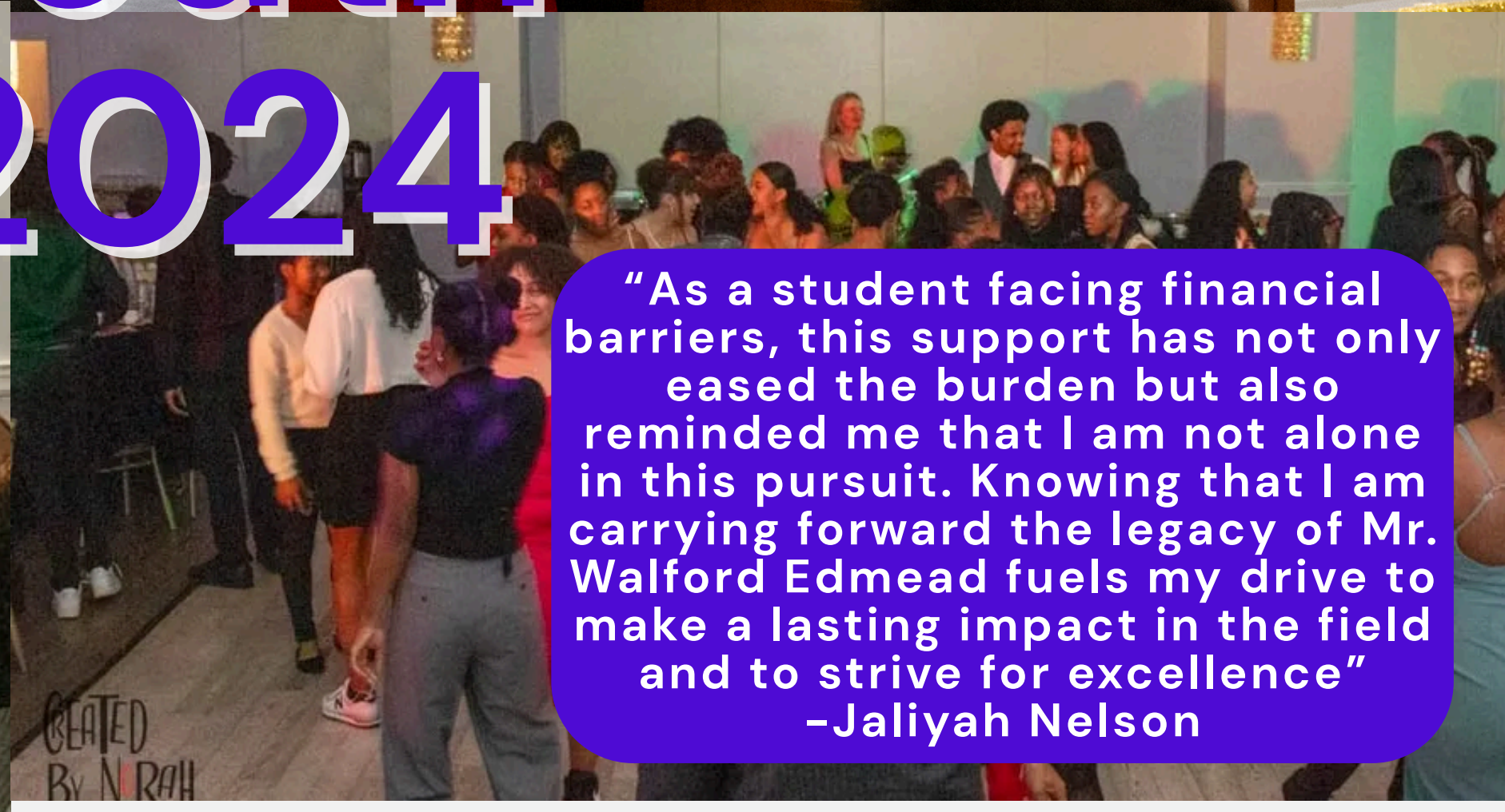

BYR Youth Leadership Conferences:
Designed for Black youth and allies across the Greater Toronto Area to address anti-Black racism, the conference allowed 50 youth to attend workshops educating about BSAs, public speaking, mental health, intersectionality, discrimination, receive career advice and network. This conference would not be possible without our partners at YOF and the Ontario Trillium Foundation.

Black Youth Market (2023, 2024)
This market provided a space for 10–15 Black youth artists and entrepreneurs to sell and showcase their products and services. The pop-up also featured a Black youth DJ, a panel of experienced Black youth entrepreneurs, catered food and more.
