Transitions groups like the timelines for data uploading/data transfer.

Peggy and David met recently. David should be billing each site for data collection asap. 15K per year to have David and his team do the work. If we went to Precision campus there would be an upfront cost. The google forms are slow, going to get slower as the data set increases. Erick from PC says there would not be a separate upload fee as consortium data would be included in the ongoing data uploads FH/DA already does. Fuzzy match is not the issue, it's the cleaning up of the data. Takes 40-50 hours to do the clean up.

Pros: web based app. Easier access for users--more inclined to base work on data.

Criteria:

Easier to use than the google sheets.

More timely. Going to quarterly uploads to really track data.

Clean data /more trustworthy than launchboard

Able to drill down on data beyond launchboard

Could be cost effective IF it really is a one time buy in.

Data is starting to inform the work: with accountability, developing of strategies, work with the state.
