      - Family Engagement Institute (use a MV school as a site)
        - Books & family support provided
      - Potential for "start your own day care" entrepreneurship option
  - Determine what additional resources we may need
    - Funding?
      - For ESL faculty to observe, support & design curriculum to support ESL learners in context
      - Current CAEP students take classes for free
    - What data do we want? [PRL & Lori will work on this in advance of the meeting]
    - ESL support—FH has a child dev for ESL learners (is credit an option) vs. learning support (non-CR)—question for the planning committee
