 - a. Jump in participants after 2023 due to in-person learning- due to students preferring in-person classes.
 - i. In 2023-24, lowered the class size and also, trend of lower level ESL students enrolling, which created a bottle neck at the bottle. Modify ESL placement test placement due to shifting esl level change
 - b. Expect to see an increase in enrollment across ESL starting in 2023- due to the waitlists that happened.
 - c. Hope to see EFL gains improve (2023) with in-person instruction
 - d. FUHSD- less HSD diploma graduates during covid due to the high school having lower requirements (130 credits) for graduation.
