Updates from September Meeting:

- → Update on Co-Chair & WG member compensations: LB is still actively working on this
- → Reach out to ESL Deans/ Chairs at the colleges to see if any teachers (adjunct/full time) would be interested in teaching at the AS. (please note that the barrier here is that instructors at the AS's are required to hold CA teaching credentials-SK)
 - Writing a consortium letter to our Representatives, Gov, and Chancellor regarding Masters TSOL=AS Teaching Credential
 - ◆ Reach out to CATESOL
 - ◆ ACSA was against this before, see where they stand now
- → Has AS scheduled any tabling sessions with Joselyn during CASAS testing? FUHSD, MVLA, & PAAS all said yes—

- → Foothill: NCEL405 winter session (Sunnyvale campus)
 - SS WG: FUHSD/MVLA/PAAS are promoting this course
 - (FUHSD is having an application workshop)
 - How is MVLA & PAAS promoting the 405 class? (this will help know how many seats to hold)
 - MVLA: Based on need.
 - Once we get dates of classes, create a flier and promote across consortium
 - ♦ Valerie Update:
 - Cass info goes to the schedule -
 - The target date to enter schedules is 10/7. However, I'm holding off on entering this class until I've confirmed the information for it. See below.
 - Any updates from the instructor on what days/times the class will be offered?
 - I will be offering Sharon a different class assignment, so I am still working on the instructor. I would like to offer the class 2 days/week, 1 hour 50 minutes each day, at Sunnyvale. I am aware that Friday mornings would work best for FUHSD, and I will try to honor that, but it may depend on instructor availability. I am working with the faculty to determine if the Friday block can be synchronous online. If so, then the ideal would be Wednesdays, 9-11:50am at Sunnyvale and Fridays, 9-11:50am synch in zoom.
 - By 10/7: It could help me to know what days/times would work best if Friday mornings are not an option.
 - ◆ What are our best days/times for this class?
 - PAAS: Morning students are in class, Mo-Th until 12:30; some take a 5th day, Friday morning (but not all) PAAS evening students are in class M/W 6:30 - 9:30, so AM or afternoon might work FUHSD:
 - MVLA (unavailable due to class: ESL/GED 9-12 pm M-F, ESL/GED 6-9 pm M-Th) I would say maybe 12:30 or in the evening
 - When do you need to know how many seats to hold for AS students:
 - \circ 11/10, would be good.
 - ◆ I looked, but just want confirmation that this course is not part of a certificate.
 - NCEL405 is not part of a CDCP certificate.
 - ◆ Josh any update on it benefiting from being a CCAP course? So the waitlist/test outs are still counted as adult school students?
 - Was not at meeting
 - ◆ LB: Not an embedded tutor class
 - SS WG looking into Sunnyvale campus wrap around support services
 - AS Target population:
 - Dual Enrollment opportunity/test outs/waitlists
 - What level AS ESL are we promoting this to. Let's discuss this
 - AS/CC ESL level Alignment Doc
 - ◆ AS High Beginning (solid students) Possible Beginning Low??

- ◆ Jon: How can AS align this with COAP / payment points?
 - The LB found a work around for this; however, for this first session we are going to not do this.
- ◆ The De Anza <u>CIS399</u> would be a more indepth computer class, so the 405 course could lead into it.
 - Winter & Spring 2013 (focus on Spring

 could it be after the 405 so it becomes a dual enrollment pathway.)
- → Best times for dual enrollment classes in general:
 - ◆ Summer
 - ◆ AM ESL classes have time conflict with attending AM CC classes and they may not be able to attend the afternoons.
 - Evening students often work during the day, a few might be able to attend the morning class.
- → Need system/procedure for AS faculty/transitions to promote these courses
 - Need to get info about the college courses we are promoting
 - ◆ Course links/info
 - ◆ Create pathway doc with all the offering for the ESL teachers and transition staff
 - Course info
 - When offered
 - Units
 - Other info?
