

Strategy #5, Seamless Transitions

Complete and implement a college transition checklist to be used consortium-wide with all college-bound adult school students. Collect baseline data (e.g. the number of students who completed checklist with support personnel at both the giving and receiving agency). [Work Group: Student Support.]

This strategy is complete.

Accomplishments include:

1. Key student support activities have been outlined and agreed upon (see website nscadulthood.com and counseling page); these activities will be offered to all transitioning students.
2. Transition Advisors/Counselor send email with overview of results of activities to accepting counselor. NOTE: Long-term goal is to have an FHDA “passport” of sorts to take with them to the receiving college. This will be worked on in 2020-2021.
3. A joint Google Sheet is being kept Transition Advisors/Counselor to track what services students are receiving and with whom they have met.
4. Transition Advisors/Counselor send email with overview of results of activities to accepting counselor.

Next steps for 2020-2021:

- Long-term goal is to have an FHDA “passport”/checklist of sorts to be filled out by students as they accomplish the activities and to take with them to the receiving college. The idea behind this is that if a student ends up with a non-adult ed specified counselor, the receiving counselor would be able to serve the student better with the information. Note: This is in addition to sending the current email that is protocol for the the “warm handoff” (See Strategy 4 for details.)
