Best practices for helping support students in transitioning from adult schools to colleges and careers

Although these steps start at the Adult Schools, Community Colleges and Adult Schools work collectively to support our students.

When applicable:

- Adult School Advisors/Counselors assist students in completion of career interest inventories and connect students to appropriate resources on college campuses and community/industry partners;
- Adult School Advisors/Counselors help all students seeking transition services: a) set career and academic goals; b) identify the individual support services needed to address challenges that might negatively impact each student's success and complete a Learning Style inventories when appropriate;
- 3. Adult School Advisors/Counselors help students complete their college application/enrollment;
- Adult School Advisors/Counselors help students obtain English and Math placement (either through AB 705 or through ESL placement test) (Updated PD needed);

- 5. Adult School Advisors/Counselors work with students and complete their FAFSA or California Dream Act applications (Updated PD needed);
- 6. Adult School Advisors/Counselors will help the student make an appointment and connect with the receiving college counselor.
