Anne Timberlake has appeared across the United States performing repertoire from Bach to twenty-first century premieres. She holds degrees in recorder performance from Oberlin Conservatory, where she studied with Alison Melville, and Indiana University, where she studied with Eva Legene and won the 2007 Early Music Institute Concerto Competition. Critics have praised her "fine technique and stylishness" and "unexpectedly rich lyricism," (*Letter V.*) and "dazzling playing," (*Chicago Classical Review*).

Anne has received awards from the American Recorder Society and the National Foundation for the Advancement of the Arts, and was awarded a Fulbright Grant. With Musik Ekklesia, she has recorded for the Sono Luinus label. She is a founding member of the ensemble Wayward Sisters, specializing in music of the early Baroque. In 2011, Wayward Sisters won Early Music America's Naxos Recording Competition. Wayward Sisters released their debut CD on the Naxos Label in 2014.

Anne enjoys teaching as well as playing. In addition to teaching private, group and online recorder lessons, Anne has coached through Indiana University's Pre-College Recorder Program, the San Francisco Early Music Society, the Amherst Early Music Festival, Virginia Baroque Performance Academy, Mountain Collegium, Mideast Early Music Workshop, Pinewood Early Music Week, and for numerous American Recorder Society chapters. Anne currently resides in St. Louis, Missouri.
