A Note from the President:

As the summer quickly comes to an end, the Board would like to thank everyone who attended the Annual Meeting and the social committee for organizing and planning the dinner.

Owners who see rule violations should report them to the management company on the MPCA website, www.marinerspointcondos.org. After the report, the board can decide on the proper action. Owners are responsible for addressing trespassers and contacting the Ashtabula County Sheriff if necessary. What would you do at your primary residence?

We have had numerous pool violations and the Board has decided to turn off the pool fob for violators until the violators have notified the management company that the owner has read and understands the rules. Six (6) people per unit includes the owners, and the owners CANNOT use their neighbors' 6 when the neighbor is not here. Owners must be on site when their guests are using the pool. The same applies to the beach.

Turning off your main water valve applies all year round. Water lines in your unit can blow at any time. Toilets, sinks, washing machines, dishwashers, and ice makers all have water lines. Hot water tanks do not last forever. Hot water tanks need to be replaced regularly. Each owner is responsible for any damage done to any other units. Owners must have insurance on their units.

Owners may park one vehicle directly in front of the sidewalk. Second vehicles and visitors need to park on the side away from the buildings.

A reminder to all owners and guests to be courteous and respect other owners. We are all here to enjoy the lake and relax. Owners must realize that sitting on your deck and talking carries and echoes in the courtyard. This goes for phone conversations as well as personal hygiene-pedicures

To maintain our community's high quality, all owners must be polite and courteous. Everyone must also read and understand the rules and regulations posted on the website.

News from the Architectural Committee:

If you are going to replace your storm door, you have some options. You can go with the "Partial View" you have now, or you can select the "Full View" with retractable screen (see photos).

Both styles are available at Home Depot (Anderson), Loew's (Larson), and other window/door retailers. You can use the store's installer or a local handyman like Jerry Weeks (440-228-7471)

The door and trim must be white and have a white strip across the middle. One-piece full glass panels are not permissible.

You can select any color hardware. Nickel is the most popular.
