



RESOLUTION

Calling Georgia's Congressional Delegation to mitigate National Debt

Whereas, the 9th District Republican Party acknowledges a well-conceived, managed budget is crucial to the sovereignty of our nation, and,

Whereas, the current United States debt is \$31.5 trillion, or 124% of annual U.S. economic output (GDP), and,

Whereas, in addition, the U.S. government has over \$124 trillion unfunded liabilities; obligations to federal retirees, Social Security, and Medicare recipients, and,

Whereas, programs such as Social Security, Medicare, and Medicaid, are essential to the welfare of our citizens, and,

Whereas, the value of our currency in foreign exchange is directly tied to fulfilling our obligations, and,

Whereas, funding and maintenance of a capable military is necessary for security of our nation; funding to control our borders is vital to our sovereignty, and,

Be it Hereby Resolved, the Delegates of this Convention encourages elected U.S. Congressional Representatives to legislate a reduction of our debt by cutting spending, not raising taxes, and to balance the budget
