



RESOLUTION

OPPOSING THE EXPANSION OF NON-PARTISAN ELECTIONS

Whereas the purpose of a political party is to establish a secure majority within government while holding those elected accountable to the principles of the party; and,

Whereas a state law mandating certain county public officials be elected in non-partisan races removes county Republican party prerogatives to determine if those offices should remain partisan; therefore,

Be it Hereby Resolved, that the Delegates of this Convention:

- 1) Oppose such action, and will denounce any Republican that supports any future legislation that takes the party out of any influence in selecting elected officials that represent the voters;
- 2) Instruct members of the General Assembly for the 9th District to oppose any attempt to remove partisan elections from the grassroots; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Secretary of Georgia Republican Party Convention is directed to immediately transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Chairman of the Georgia Republican Party and to all elected Republican officials in the Georgia Senate and in the Georgia House; to the Honorable Brian P. Kemp, Governor of the State of Georgia, the Honorable Burt Jones, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Georgia; and to the Honorable Jon Burns, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
