

A RESOLUTION TO PROTECT AMERICAN WORKERS

WHEREAS the Biden administration has opened our borders, facilitating illegal alien labor and depressing Americans' wages; and

WHEREAS the Biden administration's policies have devalued the petrodollar²; caused hyperinflation; decimated domestic steel production; allowed foreign ownership of our farmland; opened the door to destruction of food and energy supplies; and has blown our energy independence; therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the Delegates of this Convention will not support either Georgia or Federal candidates that do not protect the present and future employment security of American workers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Secretary of Georgia Republican Party Convention is directed to immediately transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Chairman of the Georgia Republican Party and to all elected Republican officials in the Georgia Senate and in the Georgia House; to the Honorable Brian P. Kemp, Governor of the State of Georgia, the Honorable Burt Jones, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Georgia, and to the Honorable Jon Burns, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
