A RESOLUTION TO improve the method of ballot adjudication

Whereas a typical ballot adjudication rate is historically less than 3%; and,

Whereas a higher than 3% adjudication rate introduces uncertainty as to voters' authenticity and intent; therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Delegates of this Convention demand GA Legislators enact legislation requiring adjudications greater than 3.5% of ballots in-count from any district be forwarded to an independent panel where adjudication will be performed by the independent panel; and further resolves the Secretary of State's office cannot appoint or contract in advance any resource or organizations so as to circumvent any pre-arranged plan, real or perceived; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Secretary of Georgia Republican Party Convention is directed to immediately transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Chairman of the Georgia Republican Party and to all elected Republican officials in the Georgia Senate and in the Georgia House; to the Honorable Brian P. Kemp, Governor of the State of Georgia, the Honorable Burt Jones, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Georgia; and to the Honorable Jon Burns, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
