

Resolution to Reconcile Unused Ballots

Whereas: The Georgia Election Code does not require the accounting of ballots that are not used in an election; and,

Whereas: The State Election Board has no rule for the accounting of unused ballots; and,

Whereas: Only two counties in the 9th congressional district count the unused ballots to reconcile all ballots which is an example of statewide counties accounting for unused ballots; and ,

Whereas: In a time of questions of election integrity, it is reasonable to require election officials in each county to be accountable to the public for all ballots, not just the voted ballots; therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the Delegates of this Convention demand the Georgia State Legislature pass election reform that will require election officials in each Georgia county to reconcile by actual count all ballots including unused ballots.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Secretary of Georgia Republican Party Convention is directed to immediately transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Chairman of the Georgia Republican Party and to all elected Republican officials in the Georgia Senate and in the Georgia House; to the Honorable Brian P. Kemp, Governor of the State of Georgia, the Honorable Burt Jones, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Georgia; and to the Honorable Jon Burns, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
