New Rule: 9.10.i

What? “Candidate Submissions - The application for all candidates seeking election/re-election shall be made available to the assembly at time of submission.”

Why? Currently, applications for candidates are not made available to the assembly. This often prevents the assembly from learning more about the candidates. Also, since the information is only being made available on a “privileged” basis, it is not equitable to the majority nor is it transparent.

New Rule: 9.1.f, 9.2.g, 9.3.d,

What: “A set of the standing convention rules shall be made available to the delegates and alternates at the time of the call. Any amendments to such standing rules prior to the convention must be itemized and presented to the assembly in advance of the convention.”

Why? The current process of not requiring the rules prior to the day of the convention is not equitable to those who are outside of the “rules committee” or “executive committee” or those who are otherwise deemed “privileged” to view/approve the rules in advance of the convention/caucus. Secondly, receiving rules the day of the convention is not a reasonable accommodation for those with disabilities.

New Rule: 9.7.a.3, 9.7.b.3, 9.7.c.4, 9.10.d

What? “A copy of the minutes shall be provided to the assembly no later than 5 days after a convention, caucus or meeting”

Why? Currently, the minutes are not being provided to the assembly in a transparent, timely nor useful manner. For example, if the minutes are at a yearly convention, the minutes are not being made available to the assembly until 72 hours prior to the next yearly convention (sometimes only at the convention). First, the assembly will not be able to recall the events that occurred a year prior. Secondly, receiving minutes the day of the convention is not a reasonable accommodation for those with disabilities.

WHEREAS, dozens of Georgia counties illegally destroyed over 1.7 million original ballot images and other election records for the November 2020 election, making it impossible to use those images to audit county election results;

BE IT RESOLVED, that we the undersigned demand our legislators and county officials to take action to alleviate Georgia voters from the burden of voting on an illegal, unverifiable voting system;
