Please note: Richard O'Brien's The Rocky Horror is rated R and contains adult content and language. Some characters are on stage partially clothed, and some portray sexualized choreography. QTC places great importance on the safety of its participants, who must be 18 years of age or older at the time of the auditions. Age verification may be required. This is a full audience participation show with callbacks from the audience, approved prop bags and pre-show performance and audience costume contests at every show. You must be comfortable in close interaction with people, in revealing clothing/underwear and sexual situations.

Non-emergency conflicts will not be excused and may affect participation in the show. Once you have accepted a role, we expect that you will finish all scheduled rehearsals and performances.

*Queer Theatre Company, a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation, requests a show participation fee of \$100, due by the first rehearsal. As a newly-formed company running shows on a minimal budget, a show fee is a simple cash injection that will get the show up and running. The initial cost of a musical is largely in securing the rights, which can be in the thousands. This can leave a new or low-budget company struggling to cover smaller expenses during rehearsals, like venue hire. This initial funding can make a big difference in getting traction in the early stages of a production. Please be assured that QTC is an all-volunteer company and that all monies go directly back into the production/company. If cast, there is an expectation that you will assist/volunteer in promotion of the show by selling tickets, posting social media, helping behind the scenes and being a positive spokesperson for the show and company.

CAST CONTRACT

As a member of the cast:

- 1. I agree to attend all rehearsals for which I am scheduled.
- 2. I will remain at rehearsals until the rehearsal is completed or I am excused.
- 3. If I must miss a rehearsal for any reason, I will personally contact production staff as soon as possible before rehearsal.
- 5. If I miss more than two rehearsals without good cause (beyond known conflicts) I understand that I may lose my role.
- 6. I agree to assist with the production of the show in any capacity.
- 7. I understand that I may be personally responsible for parts of my costume.
- 8. I understand that I am part of a team effort, so I must have a positive attitude, even on days when I have a million reasons to not be open-minded and willing to work.
- 9. I understand this show requires collaboration, and I agree to contribute the best I can at appropriate times.
- 10. I agree to pay the production fee at the first rehearsal (unless other arrangements have been agreed upon.)
- 11. I understand that this production may contain partial nudity and deals with sexual situations in a lighthearted way; has audience participation, including callbacks and props usage. You may be in different stages of undress during the performance, however, QTC does not tolerate any sexual harassment from either fellow cast or audience. THIS IS A SAFE AND AFFIRMING SPACE. No body shaming allowed.
