

# How to Print from Your Apple iPhone or iPad to an AirPrint Printer

AirPrint makes it incredibly easy to print documents, photos, and more directly from your iPhone or iPad to a compatible printer, without needing to install any drivers or extra software. Here's how to do it:

## What you'll need:

- An iPhone or iPad running iOS.
- An AirPrint-enabled printer (check your printer's manual or manufacturer's website if you're unsure).
- Both your iOS device and the printer connected to the **same Wi-Fi network**.

## Step 1: Open the App and Find What You Want to Print

Navigate to the app that contains the item you wish to print. This could be Photos, Mail, Safari, Pages, Notes, or almost any app that allows sharing or viewing documents.

For example, let's open the Safari app.

## Step 2: Tap the Share Button


Once you've found the item (e.g., a photo, a webpage, an email), look for the Share button. This is usually represented by a square with an arrow pointing upwards. Tap it to reveal the sharing options.




**Step 3: Scroll Down and Tap "Print"**

In the Share Sheet that appears, scroll down through the options until you see "Print" with a printer icon next to it. Tap this option.


This will load the Printer Options screen that allows you adjust the settings just prior to printing.

**Step 4: Check what Printers are Available**

From the Printer Options screen Tap "Select Printer." Your iOS device will search for available AirPrint printers on your Wi-Fi network.


**Step 5: Select Your Printer**

From the list of discovered printers, tap on the name of your AirPrint printer. If you don't see your printer, make sure it's turned on, connected to the same Wi-Fi network as your iOS device, and AirPrint-enabled.



### Step 6: Change any options as required

Change any options that need adjusting. You can change paper size, if available you can set the printer to duplex so it prints on both sides of the paper duplex and in this example you can choose to only print the first page.



### Step 6: Tap Print in the top right-hand corner

After you have updated the options just tap Print in the top right-hand corner and it will send the document to the printer and start printing.

It will also return you to your original app
