Follow-Up Discussion Questions

- 5. When you experience sin happening around you, do you ignore it, endure it, or confront it? Why?
- 6. Think about the idea of *rightly ordered loves*. Are yours rightly ordered? Which of yours need to be re-ordered? What do you need to do to make that happen?
- 7. What lies have you believed or sin have you allowed or indulged that's cause your loves to be wrongly ordered? What are you going to do about it?
