

# Common Core Bootcamps K-6<sup>th</sup> grade

**These sessions are for students that have struggled this year or students that want to be prepared for next year.**

Whether students need to review this year's curriculum or a preview of what's coming up next year, this bootcamp is a great option. Most of our students attend both sessions the first Summer, then attend the preview to prepare for the following school year. After our program, more than 90% of the students do not find the need for tutoring during the school year. This is our hope for you.

Always small groups

- 3 hours a day, 4 days a week (Monday – Thursday), for 3 weeks  
9-12 pm or 1-4 pm  
June 6 - 23<sup>rd</sup> or June 27<sup>th</sup> - July 21<sup>st</sup> (not mtg July 4-7)  
No make ups for missed days

- K – 5<sup>th</sup> grade, waiting list for 6<sup>th</sup> grade
- During the 3 hours we cover reading, writing, and math by grade level
- During the last 15 minutes parents are invited to learn that day's math concept and talk to the teacher
- Homework is given each night in hopes that the student will "Reteach" the concepts to their parents/guardian, further solidifying their knowledge of the subject matter. Homework is not returned.
- We are not "Teaching" every concept, we are reviewing it or introducing it to them. They will "Learn" each one during the school year. Think of it as watching a movie and then reading the book.
- The curriculum consists of reviewing the most popular concepts for the year as selected by local credentialed teachers by grade level.
- Students do not bring snacks or water bottles, we will have a short break for water and bathrooms as needed. The less distractions the better, it is a bootcamp after all. 🏠
- Always small groups, approximately 6-8 in each class and one instructor per grade
- Most of the students attend both sessions during the first Summer. The first to review this year, and the second one to preview the next year.
- Students could attend the review and the preview on the same day, if they wish.
- We offer a 10% discount on the second class, and 10% off siblings in the same household after full price of first student is paid. Cash payments are at 5% off.
- If you need additional tutoring we can offer very limited private one on one tutoring before or after class, Friday, Saturday or Sundays, as well
- This curriculum is also available during our 1-1 private tutoring, expect to accomplish the series in about 18 hours. Depending on how quickly your child grasp the concepts. These are at \$40 an hour.
- We are not meeting during July 4-7<sup>th</sup>.
- **Bootcamps are \$499 for 36 hours of learning.**
