



Follow these steps in preparation for Flea Service \* 405-582-2114

On \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_ to \_\_\_ AM/PM, an ABBS PC Service Professional will stop by to treat for fleas.

Fleas are most often spread by dogs and cats. These insects feed on the blood of pets and lay eggs that fall off onto carpets, rugs, and upholstered furniture.

Successful control of a flea infestation relies heavily on customer participation. Follow the list of preparations below before the ABBS PC Service Professional arrives to maximize the treatment's effectiveness.

### Before the Service

- Vacuum all floors, carpets, and rugs.
- Remove all items from floors, the bottom of closets and under the bed. Place items on a bed or table.
- Pick up all non-furniture items from the floor and place on a bed or table.
- Vacuum under the bed and the floor of closets.
- Mop all tile, linoleum, and wood floors thoroughly.
- Vacuum under all cushions of upholstered furniture, especially if pet(s) like to rest or sleep on them.
- Clean or replace all pet bedding.
- Remove pet food and litter from floors.
- Place a paper towel sheet in places pet(s) like to rest or sleep. This will alert the ABBS Service Professional to pay close attention to such areas.
- Arrange to have your pet(s) treated by a veterinarian the same day as the flea service by ABBS.
- Aquariums should be covered by a heavy towel and the air pump disconnected. Saltwater tanks need to be removed from the premises since the air pumps cannot be disconnected.
- All people and pets (including birds, reptiles, etc.) need to remain out of the space until the treatment has dried and after ventilating the rooms (e.g. open windows.)
- Turn off air conditioners prior to leaving.

### After the Service

- Do not re-enter treated premises until treatment has dried.***
- Turn on air conditioning system to ventilate the home.
- Vacuum carpets and rugs daily or as often as possible. This activity stimulates adult fleas hiding in cocoons to emerge where they may contact the treatment.
- You may see fleas for up to two weeks following this service. Daily vacuuming of infested rooms helps speed the control process.
