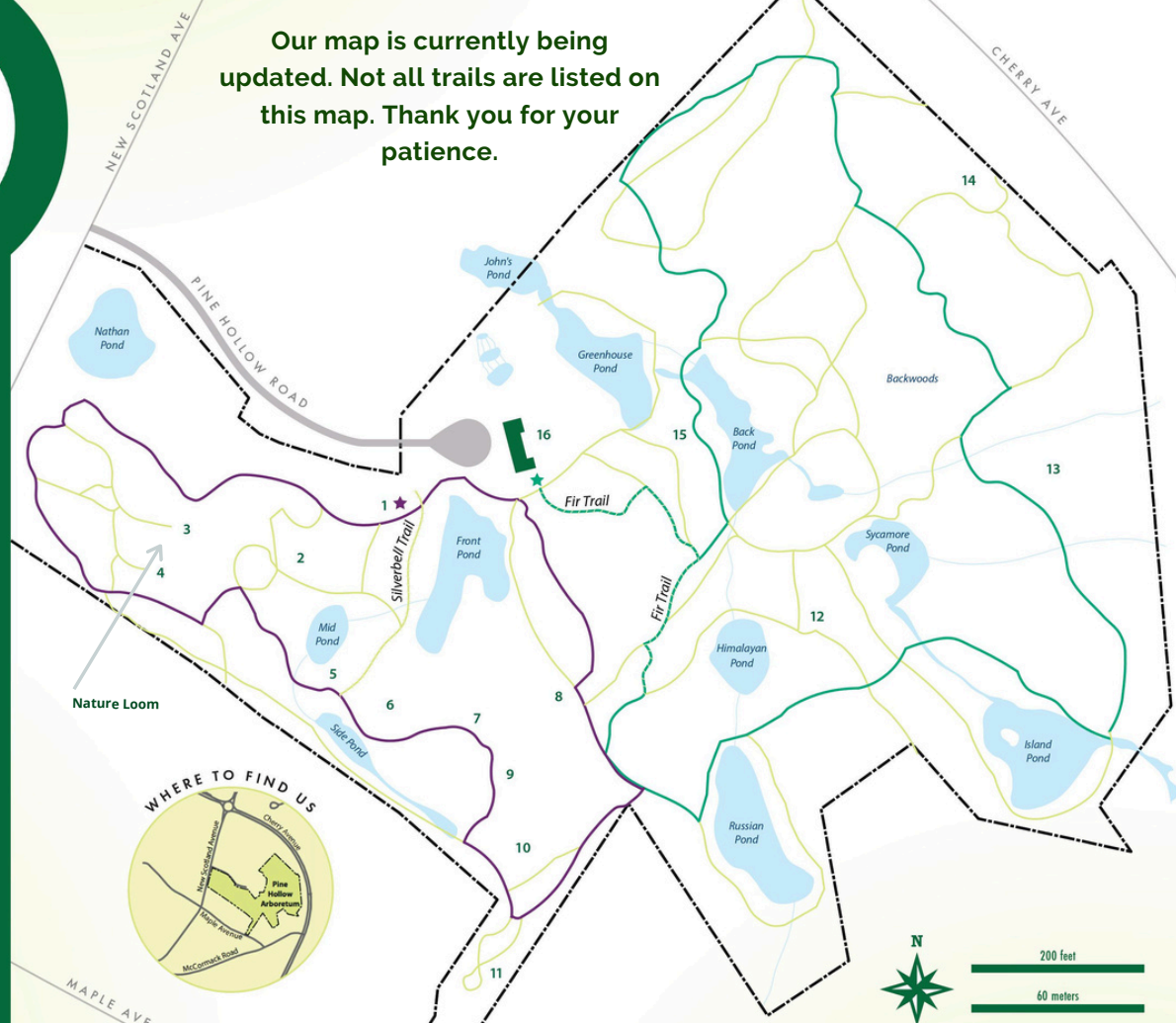

HISTORY

The Pine Hollow Arboretum (PHA) was founded by Dr. John W. Abbuhl, a local pediatrician in the area, who began planting trees around his home to create an attractive setting beginning in 1966. Dr. Abbuhl used the guiding philosophy "trees in a natural environment" to describe the arboretums natural landscape that showcases trees from around the world within the already existing native eastern white pine forest. This concept creates an incredibly different type of experience for our visitors and is a great example of how introduced plantings can be done in an ecologically conscious way.

Pine Hollow Arboretum's mission is to preserve, manage and enhance native and introduced species of trees, shrubs and other plants in the natural and aesthetic environment. We provide hands-on environmental education opportunities and are a natural resource for health and wellness activities.

ABOUT US

PHA is a Level II Accredited Arboretum and has a collection of over 3,600 unique trees and shrubs in addition to 11 ponds. Our horticultural collection provides insight into the biodiversity of the world's forests while demonstrating how one can landscape for aesthetics while serving a larger ecological purpose.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Pine Hollow hosts over 3,000 visitors annually from all over the world, and is Albany County's only arboretum. PHA offers a wide array of interactive classes and events with a mission of promoting environmental stewardship and sustainability. In the 2024/2025 season, PHA will welcome over 200 3rd graders from Albany City School's. PHA also provides informal educational and cultural program opportunities such as Monarch Mondays, Forest Bathing Walks, Poetry readings, Live Concerts, architectural tours of our Founder's home, and more!
