- Design research

- Code research
- Schematic design understand space, sizes, proportions
- · Coordinate early need items such as power, data and backing
- Develop preliminary sign plan for review
- · Create initial programming, verbiage for client input
- Design development team comments, details, specs, budget review
- Bid Drawings final design intent, guide for fabricator's shop drawings
