

Regular Meeting of the Bremond City Council

The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday September 18, 2025, with the following present: Mayor Wilganowski; Councilmember's Mayor Pro-Tem Burnett, Mikolajewski, Boudreaux, Cook, Kujawa, City Secretary Zan, Chief Cook, Public Works Director Kloss, Susan Jones, Jordan Wachel and Abby White.

1. Mayor Wilganowski called the meeting to order at 6:31p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Public comments on non-agenda items- No one.
4. Public comments on agenda items- Susan Jones, Jordan Wachel and Abby White addressed the Council regarding moving Halloween Friday October 31, 2025, to Saturday November 1, 2025.
