The regular meeting of the Bremond City Council was held in the City Hall at 6:30pm, Thursday November 20, 2025, with the following present: Mayor Wilganowski, Pro-Tem Burnett; Councilmember's Mikolajewski, Boudreaux, Kujawa, Cook, City Secretary Zan, Kie Muzyka, Nancy Gadbois and Robert Gadbois.

1. Mayor Wilganowski called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.

19. Councilmember Burnett made a motion to approve closing the Bremond Volunteer Dept. Pension & Retirement Fund South Star Bank checking account and depositing the fund balance of \$700.00 dollars into the City of Bremond General Fund Account. Second by Councilmember Boudreaux. Vote unan.

21. Councilmember Kujawa made a motion to approve City of Bremond purchase of 109 E. Collin Street property for \$3000.00 dollars. Second by Councilmember Burnett. Vote unan.
22. Councilmember Boudreaux made a motion to approve Mayor Wilganowski getting a cost for cleaning up 317 N. Market St. Property and putting a lien on it. Second by Councilmember Kujawa. Vote unan.
